Use the Training Fund's staff directory on our website.

- Visit www.healthcareerfund.org
- Select the "About Us" tab along the top of our homepage
- Click the "Staff Directory" option
- Look for staff with the Regional Education Navigator title, and match your employer's location to the region that Navigator serves (For example, UW Northwest Hospital and Medical Center is in North Seattle, so Patti K. would be your Navigator).
