## Application

Steps to Apply:

1. Apply to the Training Fund to receive funding for tuition and books at: [www.healthcareerfund.org](http://www.healthcareerfund.org)
2. Meet with Vernon Brown to review your official transcripts and apply for Tuition Assistance benefits
3. Apply to **Bellevue College's** RN-to-BSN program at: [www.bellevuecollege.edu/nursing](http://www.bellevuecollege.edu/nursing).

## Academic Requirements

**Bellevue College's** flexible RN-to-BSN program consists of up to 47 credits and takes one year to complete. Entry requirements are: Math 146 (Statistics) at most area community/technical colleges or Math 130 at Bellevue College and completion of your ADN at a regionally accredited school.

## Class Schedule

In person instruction will take place Fridays at **Bellevue College** throughout the one year program. All remaining instruction will take place online, allowing participants plenty of flexibility to fit their unique schedules.

## Costs

Training Fund Tuition Assistance is available to defray an individual's tuition/books/fee costs up to \$5,250 (per year) for full-time employees. Tuition Assistance for part-time employees is pro-rated based on FTE status.

## Eligibility

This opportunity is open to Training Fund eligible RNs who:

- Have been working at your employer for one year by program start date
- Have no written corrective action on file within the past 12 months by program start date
- Have at least a 0.10 FTE (per diem employees are not eligible for Training Fund benefits)
