Training Fund Announces New Tuition Assistance Enrollment Process

Now that the Training Fund is serving more members than ever, we have established two enrollment periods for the Tuition Assistance program. This new process allows the Training Fund to fairly manage disbursements of Tuition Assistance funds while serving the greatest number of members.

This update applies to members of all bargaining units applying for Tuition Assistance for school starting in 2020 (and beyond). If you're already receiving Tuition Assistance, you do not need to reapply; please check with your Regional Education Navigator about maintaining your eligibility.

The Training Fund accepts applications year-round and will review for Tuition Assistance after two enrollment period deadlines each year: October 15 and May 15. If you are thinking about Tuition Assistance for school in 2020, apply by October 15.

Members are encouraged to apply any time during the year so that you can be connected with career counseling, education navigation, and other benefits you may be eligible for in support of your education and career goals. However, members will only receive decisions about Tuition Assistance after the enrollment periods close. Tuition Assistance funding spots are based on seniority in your Bargaining Unit at your employer.
