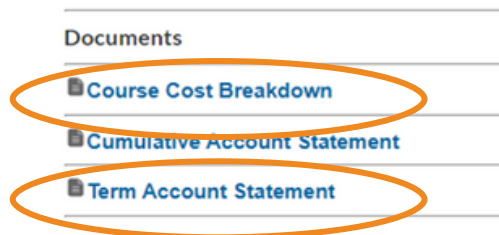
Degree plan details can be found in your acceptance letter. If you cannot locate your degree plan details, please reach out to your WGU mentor immediately requesting the document.

Required every term after first term

You can access an account summary through your MyWGU Account. Go to Student Support > Financial Services > Scroll down to Documents. Click on the document for it to download to your computer.

Unofficial Transcript

Not required for first-time funders

You can access and download your unofficial WGU transcript from within the WGU Student Portal. Once logged in, proceed to the "Student Support" tab and select "Student Services". There you will be able to download an Unofficial Transcript.

Tuition Payment: You must make tuition payment arrangements by the Tuition Deadline prior to your start date. Complete tuition information can be found at wgu.edu.

Student Orientation: You must successfully complete Orientation. This course will help you understand WGU's competency-based approach to education and your own learning style, as well as develop your online research skills, time management and study skills, and practice online communications such as threaded discussions and chat as you connect with other students and mentors online.

Registration: Prior to registration you will work with your Student Mentor to create a Personalized Degree Plan. The Degree Plan includes a schedule of the courses you will be required to complete during your first term and the learning resources available for each course. Following this discussion, you will verify course registration in your Student Portal. As a WGU student you must maintain On Time Progress (OTP) in each six-month term to maintain your academic standing and stay on track for graduation.

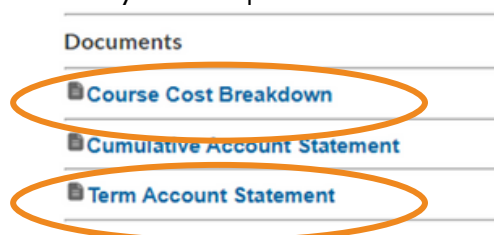
